The Part Time Children's Ministry Assistant Director of Preschool will report directly to Kimberly Enns, Director of Children's Ministry.

Job Overview

To provide support to our Children's Ministry Director, Kimberly Enns, in our Children's Ministries here at WestPark Church.

Responsibilities and Duties

Involved in various aspects of ministry which include:

- 20 hours a week (8:00 – 1:00 on Sundays plus 15 hours during the week)
- Upholding the mission and vision of WestPark Church.
- Meeting regularly with our Children's Ministry Director to receive ministry coaching (strategy) and personal care (shepherding).
- Being involved in various aspects of the Children's Ministry including managing volunteers, onboarding volunteers, check in/greeters, buddies, child dedication classes, training, administration, birthdays, and staff meetings
- Provide administrative and ministry support where needed
- Functioning as part of our ministry staff team at West Park. This includes:
 - Participating in weekly staff meetings that emphasize team building, communication, problem solving, and prayer.
 - Contributing to various churchwide initiatives.
 - Performing any additional duties as needed or directed.
